

**TOWN OF MANCHESTER
Ordinance No. 181**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RE-ENACTING WITH
AMENDMENTS SECTION 96-16 OF CHAPTER 96 - VEHICLES AND
TRAFFIC - OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF MANCHESTER.**

**ARTICLE 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND
COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MANCHESTER, MARYLAND** that Section
96-9 of Chapter 96 - Vehicles and Traffic - of the Code of the Town of Manchester
be repealed and re-enacted with amendments as follows:

§ 96-9. Turns at intersections.

No person shall make a turn of the kind designated (left, right, all) at any of
the intersections described below:

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Prohibited Turn	At Intersection of
Augusta Road	South	all	Fridinger Mill Rd (weekdays between 6am-8:30am with the exception of school buses)
Millie Way	South	all	Fridinger Mill Rd (weekdays between 6am-8:30am) with the exception of school buses)

ARTICLE 2. Severability.

Should any provision, section, paragraph or subparagraph of this Ordinance,
including any Code or text adopted hereby, be declared null and void, illegal,
unconstitutional, or otherwise determined to be unenforceable for a court having
jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity, legality, or enforceability of any
other provision, section, paragraph or subparagraph hereof, including any Code or

text adopted hereby. Each such provision, section, paragraph or subparagraph is expressly declared to be and is deemed severable.

ARTICLE 3. Section Headings, Chapter Headings, Titles.

Section headings, chapter headings, titles, etc., are for the purpose of description or ease of use and do not form a part of the text of this Ordinance or any Code or text adopted hereby.

ARTICLE 4. Existing Liabilities.

This Ordinance shall not discharge, impair or release any contract, obligation, duty, liability or penalty whatever existing on the date of its enactment. All suits and actions, both civil and criminal pending or which may hereafter be instituted for causes of action now existing or offenses already committed against any law or ordinance affected by the adoption of this Ordinance shall be instituted, proceeded with and prosecuted to final determination and judgment as if this Ordinance had not become effective.
